SUMMARY

Under the direct supervision of the Parks Foreman, this position is responsible for; assisting of the care and maintenance of parks, special facilities, parkways, medians, recreation areas and municipal building areas within the City.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Assists in the planting, care and maintenance of lawns, shrubs and flowers; assists in the renovation and repair of baseball fields, tennis courts, soccer fields and playgrounds through out the City; installs efficient irrigations systems; assists in the annual Holiday decorating throughout the City

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Work involves physical labor in the care and cleaning of restrooms, picnic areas, store and parking lots including the replacement of consumable materials such as toilet paper and paper towels and general grounds maintenance. Picks up trash on park grounds and keeps the park clear of all litter. Performs routine safety checks which may include maintenance equipment and playgrounds.

PHYSICAL ABILITIES

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 100 pounds. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

A High School Diploma or GED equivalent, plus two (2) to three (3) years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Possess and maintain a valid Driver's License.

WORK ENVIRONMENT
